

Nasal Splint made in X-LITE®

- 1. Print the pattern. Be aware the printer settings are set to actual size or 100%.
- 2. Check the size on the patient. Correct pattern size if necessary.
- 3. Use the pattern to cut the material to the correct size. Choose preferred quality of X-LITE® material.
 - a. X-LITE® Classic I- 2 layers recommended
 - b. X-LITE® Premium 2 layers recommended
 - c. X-LITE® Plus I-2 layers recommended
- 4. Protect wounds or scars with appropriate dressings.
- 5. Heat X-LITE® material in a splint bath set at 70°C alternatively you can use a small bowl with hot water. If using more than one layer of X-Lite®, ensure that the layers are well laminated by pressing them together. Trim the pattern lines on the splint to avoid sharp edges.
- 6. Reheat the material before you apply the splint on the patient. The material will stick to the dressing. Secure the splint with tape if necessary.
